Repeatability

We determine how well each person's evaluation agrees with one generally accepted by experienced assessors (i.e. a 'gold standard'). High agreement allows us to confidently compare results from different assessors and from the same assessor over time.

To measure agreement between assessors, we calculate a kappa statistic. This takes into account agreement by chance. For example, when something is rarely seen, assessors will score a lot of "no" responses, resulting in more agreement by chance.

How to interpret your score:

| Score | Repeatability |
|----------------|---------------|
| 0.80 - 1.00 | Very good |
| 0.60 - 0.80 | Good |
| 0.40 - 0.60 | Moderate |
| 0.20 - 0.40 | Fair |
| Less than 0.20 | Poor |
